The police and Child Protective Services notified Jane's mother and was told that unless she could provide housing and items necessary for sustainability, her little girl would be taken from her and placed in foster care. The Child Protective Services worker told her about our programs and referred Jane and her mother immediately. The family was given a more than just clothing and school supplies, they were given a brand new mattress, brand new bedding and hygiene supplies. Best of all, Jane and her mother were able to stay together because of the aid we provided and the hope that they were given.
